ROSSO DI MONTALCINO 2007

Rosso di Montalcino has the feel of Brunello, its big brother, but is more easygoing to drink. The 2007 Rosso from Pinino has an open and engaging nose, reminiscent of redcurrant and white blossom. The palate is velvety with generous tones of fruit and a savoury edge; its presence lingers long in the mouth. This is an incredibly impressive Rosso di Montalcino that punches well above its weight.

The Pinino estate is located to the north of the town of Montalcino, embedded into the beautiful hillside of Montoso and, although only 16 hectares in size, its wines have been creating big waves amongst the wine trade. Pinino was originally founded in 1874 by Tito Costanti, one of Montalcino's public notaries; in 2003 the estate was bought by Andrea Gamon and her partner who have since reinvigorated it with the purchase of new vineyards in Canchi and the construction of a modern wine cellar. From a background as a successful business consultant and entrepreneur, Gamon has pulled this estate into the 21st century and given it the life it desperately needed to grow.
